Thank you for coming along to support your child at their Student Led Conference this week. Once again we were very close to having a 100% booking rate and have made arrangements to catch up with conferences that we couldn't schedule over the two nights. A strong partnership between children, home and school is an important part of ensuring ongoing educational success. Next Wednesday 5 July, (early next term for Ruru) we will be sending you the first of two written reports detailing your child's progress and achievement across the curriculum, including key competencies. These reports will also show your child's interim achievement against the national standards along with planned next steps in their learning. National standards are aspirational benchmarks set after each of the first three years of school and then at the end of Year 4, 5 and 6. The vast majority of our learners have not yet reached their next milestones and will be given an interim judgement in consideration of this. Please keep this in mind when reading your child's report. We recommend taking a strengths based approach with reports and student led conferences, focussing on the successes that your child has achieved and helping them to set goals for the new term.

I would like to congratulate Matua Rawiri and our Kapa Haka group on a wonderful performance to welcome Matariki on Monday. This group have worked exceptionally hard in the five months that they have been together and have made excellent progress. It was also a privilege to welcome our Kaumatua and Kuia Whare and Virginia Heta to our special assembly.

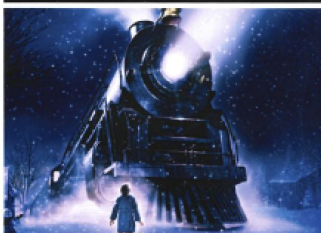

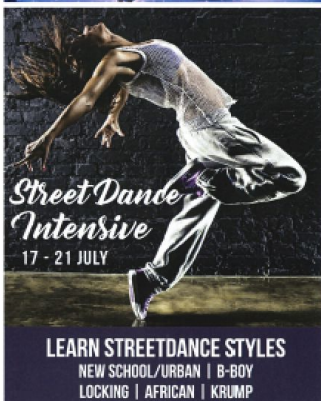

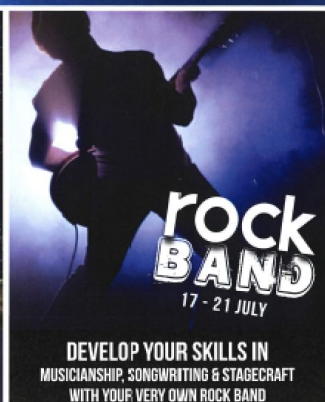
