The next few weeks at Goodwood School will be very exciting. A number of events that have needed to be cancelled due to COVID over the past two years will be making welcome returns. These include sports and cultural events and our middle team camp.

Our team is looking forward to working in partnership with you to deliver safe, fun and worthwhile events. As always we strive to provide learning activities that are relevant and inclusive. We continue to learn and adapt to meet the needs of our explorers and their whānau. You may have noticed that our kapa haka uniforms have evolved, now including singlets.
